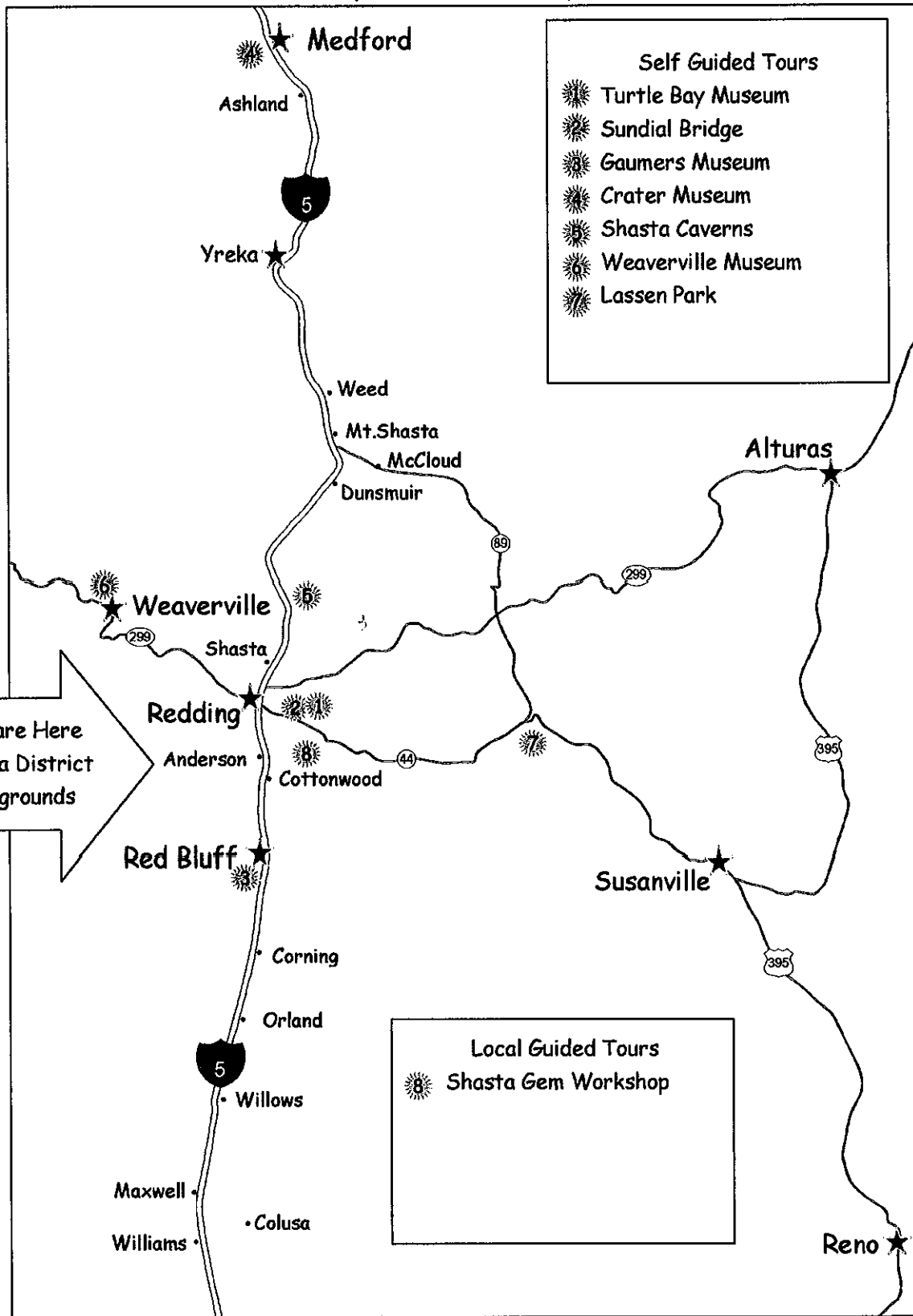

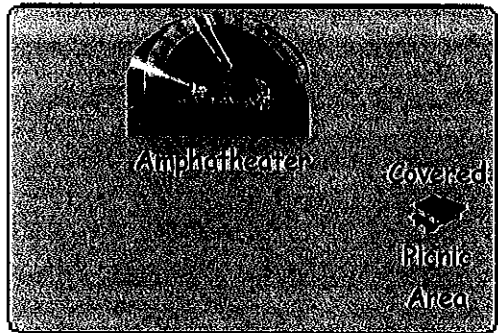

Continue I-5 North - Bonnyview Road Exit - 2 Miles



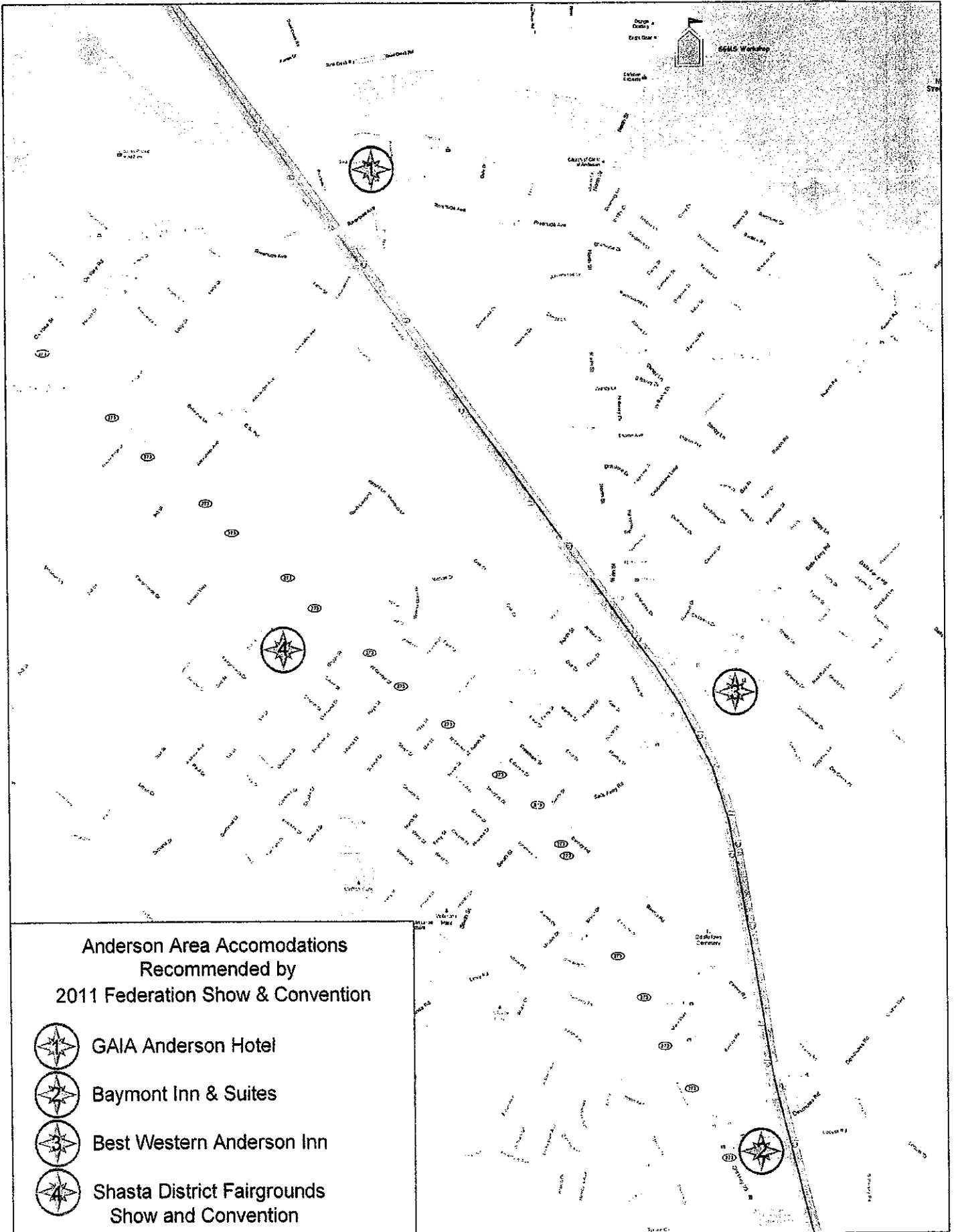

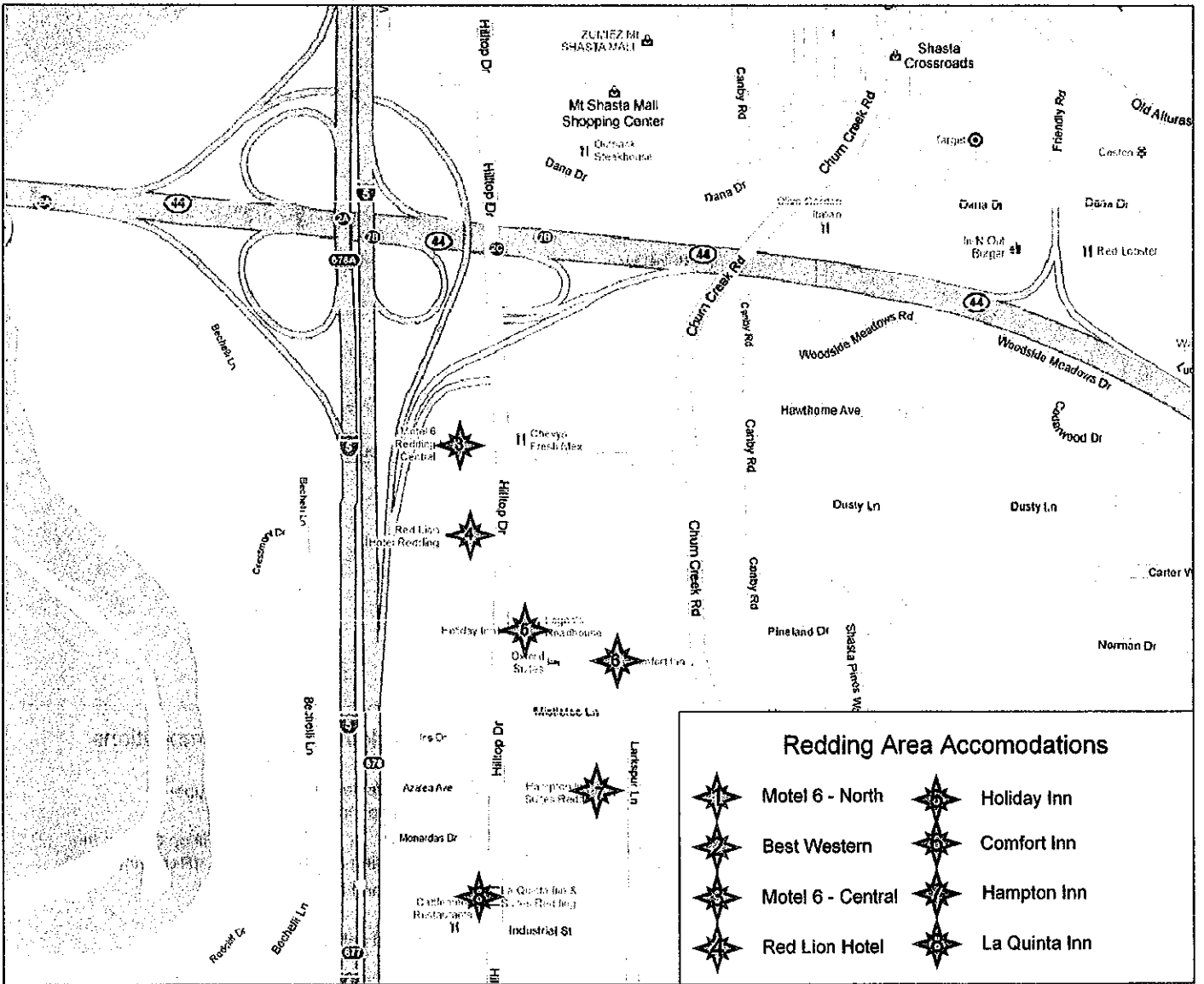
Redding Vicinity & Hotel Map

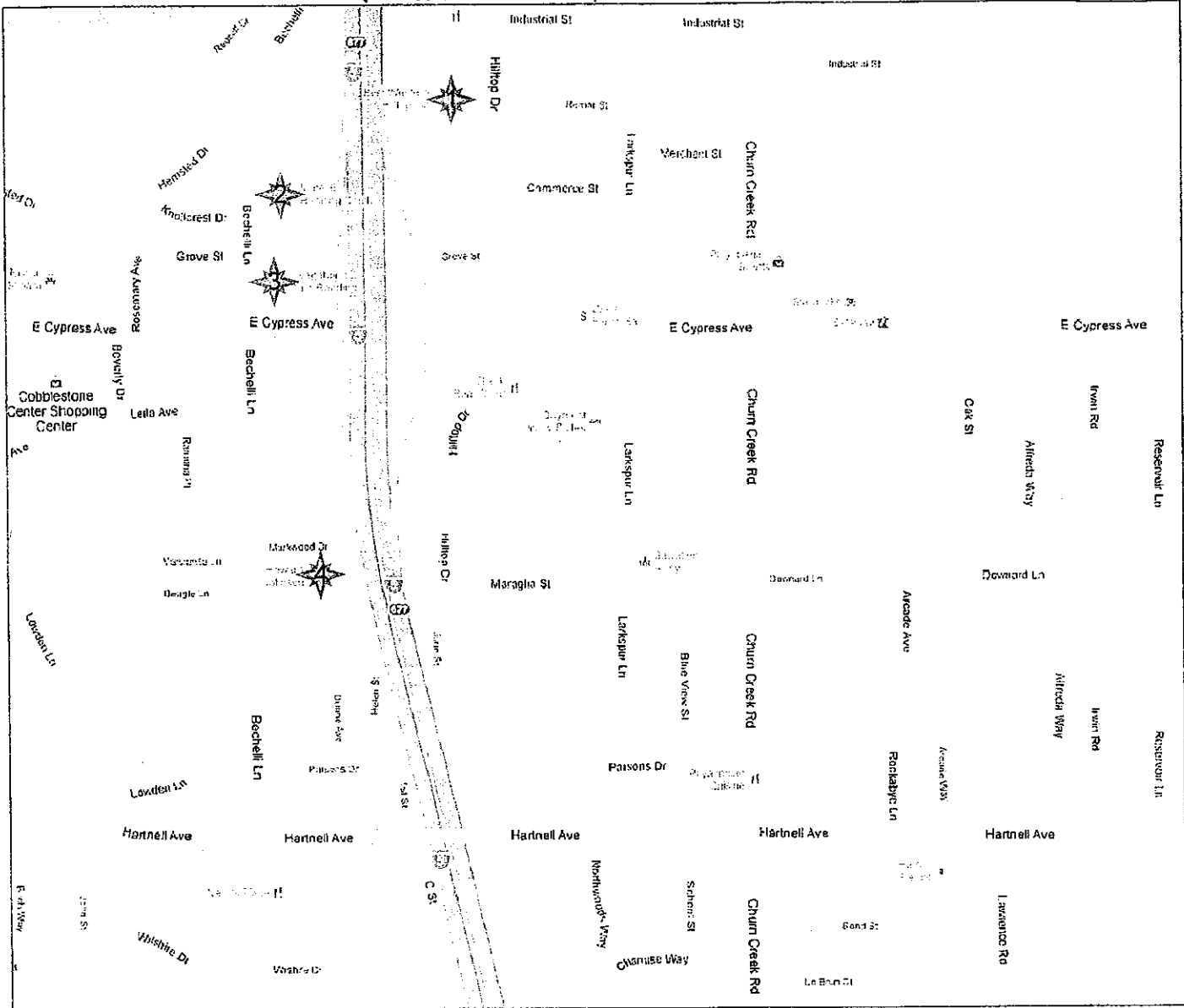


Continue I-5 North - Twin View Boulevard Exit - 3 Miles

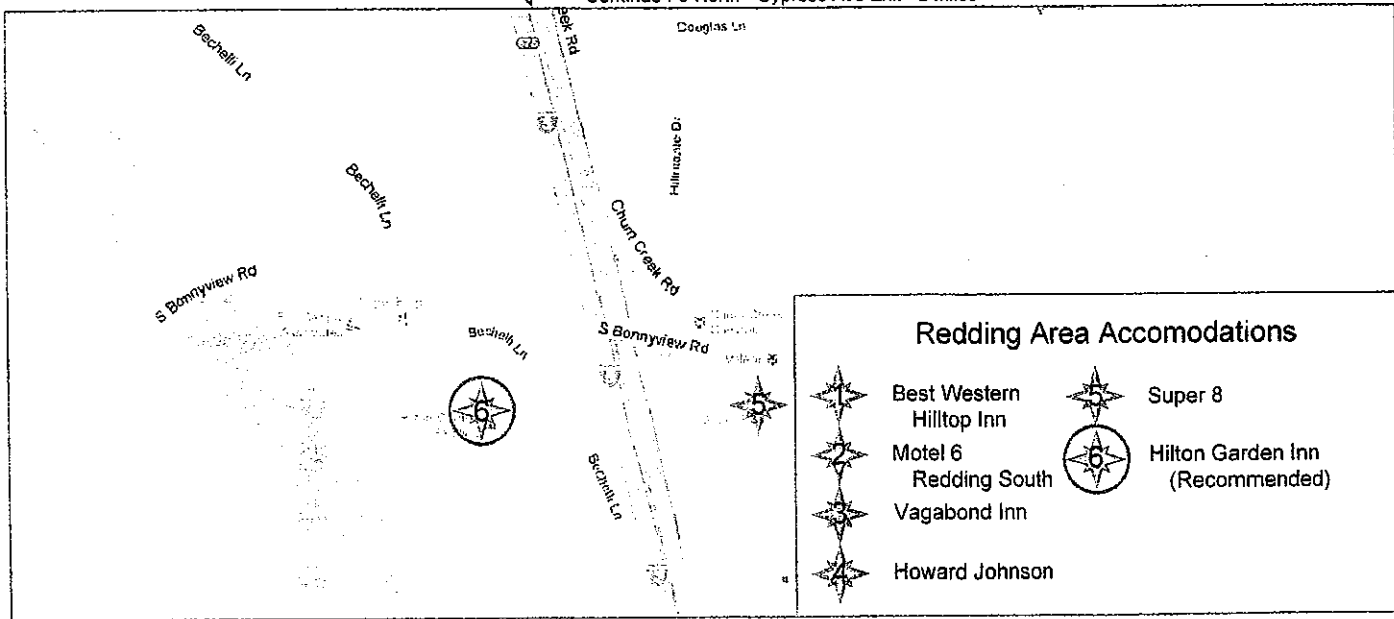


Continue I-5 South - Cypress Ave Exit - 2 Miles
